Answer is proofed, engages the reader and provides an authentic and memorable insight into strengths the applicant processes. Goals are connected to strengths and suggest self-reflection.



PERSONAL STATEMENT (Question 2):

What has been a valuable experience you have had while attending Mapleton (JROTC, music programs, art programs, science fair, school club, etc.), and what did you learn form it? (100 min-200 max words)

HOW TO GET A PERFECT SCORE:

Answer is proofed, engages the reader, and provides an authentic and memorable insight into the applicant's experience in Mapleton. Example depict a strong connection to community.





PERSONAL STATEMENT (Question 3):

How might your success in the next five years be positive for your life as well as your family and/or community?

(100 min-200 max words)

HOW TO GET A PERFECT SCORE:

Answer is proofed and provides authentic and memorable insight into realistic and specific positive future outcomes related to the applicant's strengths and goals.

HOW TO GET A PERFECT SCORE:

Applicant demonstrates a deep and sustained commitment to one or more activities outside of the classroom environment.

Applicant has held a leadership position and/or has been the recipient of honors or awards.



Adams County Scholarships

- \$10,000 to \$20,000 scholarship (\$2,500 to \$5,000 per year for four years)
- Must attend <u>public Colorado college</u> in the next academic year
- <u>Financial Aid eligible</u> Student Aid Index [SAI] for 25/26 is less than 250% the highest Pell Eligibility.

DECLINING OR DEFERING YOUR SCHOLARSHIP:

The MEF requests you contact us to request a one-year deferral if...

- You are completing military basic training
- You have an emergency that will delay your college attendance

The MEF requests you contact us to decline your scholarship if...

- You earn so much financial aid or other scholarship funds that you no longer need it
- You no longer meet the scholarship requirements
- You decide (for certain) not to go to college or trade school
